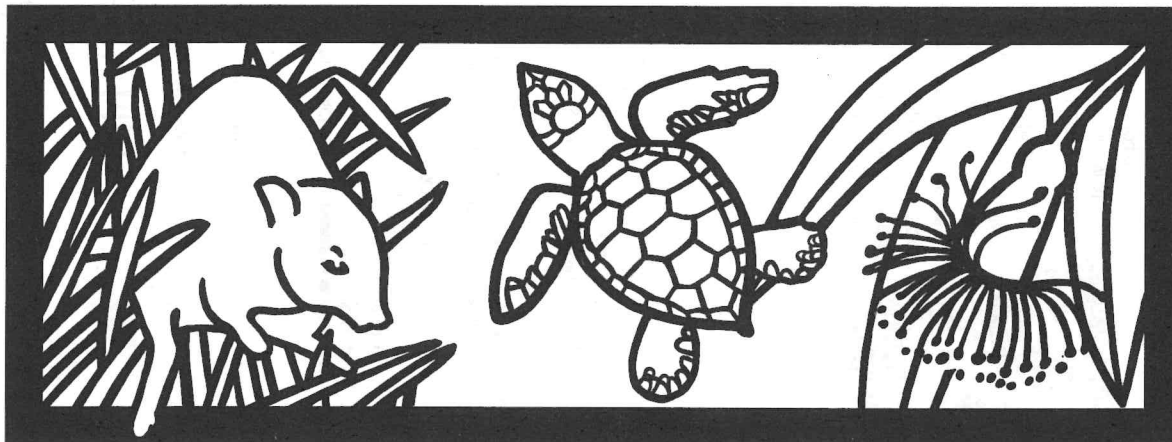

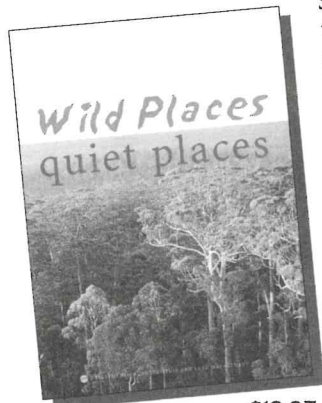

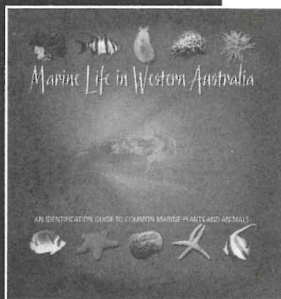
Marine Life in Western Australia CD

Video clips, voice-overs, interactive keys and the option to print text make the CD easy to run, use, explore and learn from.



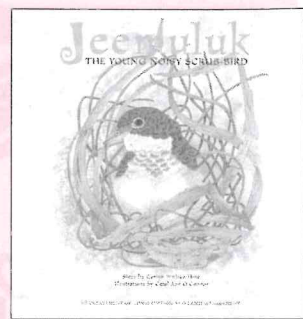
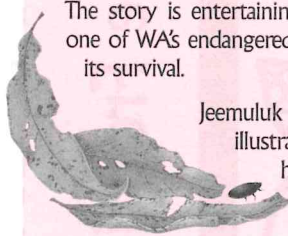
Jeemuluk: The young noisy scrub bird

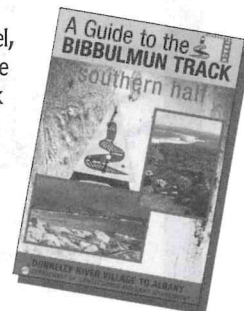
