

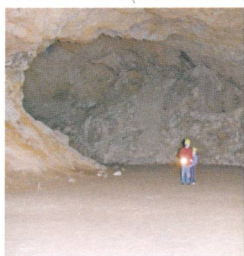

Explore the beauty of magnificent underground caverns at your own pace.

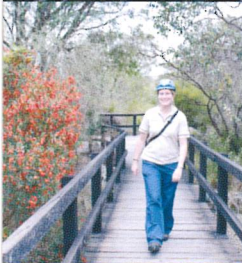


Sit and experience the beauty of **Calgardup Cave**.

Calgardup Cave

Take a stroll into Calgardup Cave's magnificently decorated chambers. Find colourful crystal, stalactites, stalagmites and walls of flowstone.

Suitable for all ages.

Path and stairs through cave.
Entry 9am–4.15pm.

Giants Cave

Scramble over rocks, negotiate ladder climbs and take yourself through a cave of gigantic size.

Not suitable for children under six years' old.

Entry 10am–1pm daily, except:

- open 9.30am–3.30pm during WA school and public holidays
- closed May to August except for bookings.

Bring enclosed footwear and a sense of adventure! Helmets, lights and a friendly reception are supplied at both sites.
