Located in the Mundaring National Park (just near the Mundaring Weir), the centre is beautifully designed and provides seven day a week visitor information, as well as offering a variety of drinks, snacks and locally made art and craft.

Facilities at the centre are clean and comfortable with universal access.

Package 1 – No cost

Drop into the centre with your tour group and gather around the rammed earth amphitheatre while a Department of Environment and Conservation staff member provides interesting information about the centre and the wonderful things that happen here. Use the facilities, browse in the shop and relax in the serenity of the forest.



Package 2 - No cost

As for package 1 with the inclusion of a leisurely self-guided walk through the Weir View Walk trail. The 1.5km loop walk offers magnificent views of the Mundaring Weir. Free maps are available.



Package 3 – From \$165 for a group of up to 20

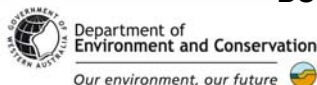
