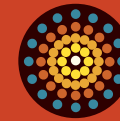

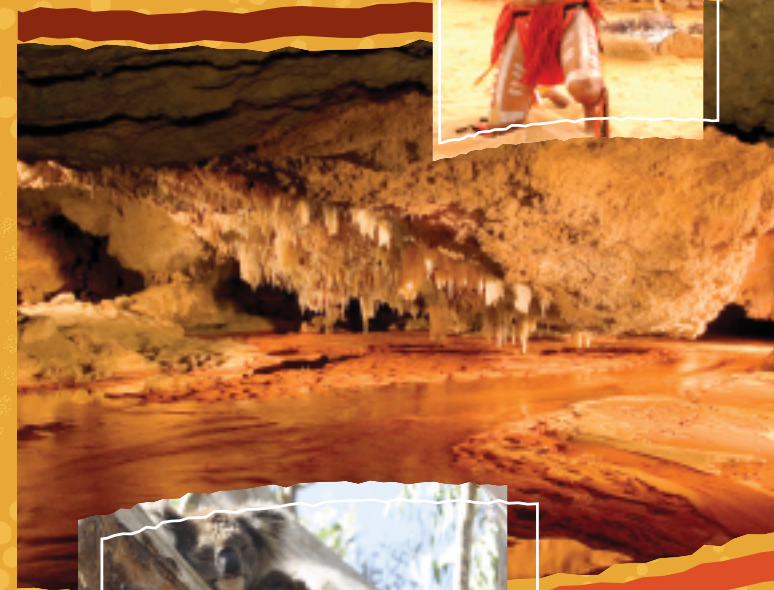

## Get nearer to nature

Experience the free 240m boardwalk through the koala enclosure. Koalas are on display every day of the year. Kangaroos, emus and cockatoos are just a few of the other animals that are seen daily within the park.

Experience one of the nine walk trails. Choose from a 20 minutes stroll through a collapsed cave system or pack your camping gear and hike the three and a half day Coastal Plains Walk Trail. Camping huts, rainwater tanks and bush toilets are located at four sites. Maps available at the Visitor Centre.

Hire a rowboat or enjoy a leisurely cruise around the lake on the Wagardu Lake Tour.



## Aboriginal Cultural tours
