Calgardup Cave

Take a stroll into Calgardup Cave's magnificently decorated chambers. Find colourful crystal, stalactites, stalagmites and walls of flowstone.

Suitable for all ages.

Path and stairs through cave.
Entry 9am–4.15pm every day.

Giants Cave

Scramble over rocks, negotiate ladder climbs and take yourself through a cave of gigantic size.

Not suitable for children under six.

Open 10am–1pm October to April and 9.30am–3.30pm during WA school and public holidays.

Closed May to September except for weekends, holidays and prior bookings.

Bring enclosed footwear to visit Giants Cave and a sense of adventure! Helmets, lights and a friendly reception are supplied at both sites.

Both caves are closed Christmas Day and Boxing Day.
