Day Tours

1. Environmental and Cultural Activity Day

only \$95 per person

Join in with Park staff on an array of different conservation projects, which could include seed collection, planting trees, working in caves, and much more. Projects change frequently. For an extra \$25 dollars per person upgraded accommodation to the Yanchepp Inn can be arranged.



What to expect

- **Koala Photo** - Photo of yourself and one of the koalas.
- **Koala Talk**
Learn about the life cycle, habitat, threats and much more about this great Australian native animal.



- **Bush Walk**

One of our Aboriginal guides will take you 'out bush'. Along the way you will learn about different flora and fauna and have the opportunity to taste some of the local bush tucker in season.

- **Share the Dreaming**

Join an Aboriginal guide as they take you for a tour through the Balga Mia Village and teach you about their traditional lifestyle and culture.

- **Didgeridoo and Dance**

This is a dance lesson with a difference. Watch some traditional dancing and then have a go yourself! Whilst catching your breath listen to the enchanting sounds of the Didgeridoo.



- **Crystal Cave**

Explore the underground world of a limestone cave. Learn about how they formed, what features they contain, and endangered cave life that inhabit this cave.

- **Adventure Caving***

Crawl around, under and over rocks with one of our expert guides in our adventure caves. What better way to spend the day! Your clothes will get dirty!
