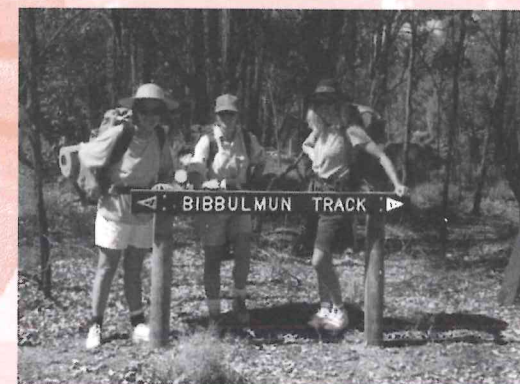

OUT THE TRACK

'new' Bibbulmun Track, completed 13 Sept 98, stretches 964km from Kalamunda to Albany across some of the most beautiful, beautiful areas of Western Australia.

There are excellent maps available and the Track is clearly marked with yellow 'waugal' (mythical snake) arrows to guide you. Along the route 47 bush walker campsites each offer a sided wooden hut with bunks, picnic table, water tank, and toilet.

Whatever your age or level of fitness, the Bibbulmun Track has an adventure for you, ranging from a relaxing moon stroll to an 'end-to-end' adventure that could change your life.

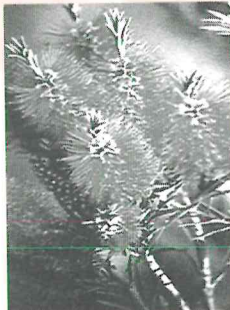
