Where is it ?

A walk for all seasons

In the far south west corner of Western Australia, a broad peninsula projects into the Indian Ocean. Running north to south along it's western edge, between Cape Naturaliste and Cape Leeuwin, is a windswept limestone ridge, perched on a basement of ancient and resistant granite rocks. This long thin strip of land forms the backbone of the Leeuwin-Naturaliste National Park.

This is the setting of the Cape to Cape Walk Track, a 140 km long trail which enables hikers to complete the Track from end to end, or walk short sections revelling in the magnificent coastal scenery, heathlands and forests of the Leeuwin-Naturaliste Ridge.
