WAPINE is pine timber planted, grown, milled and processed in Western Australia. It is available in a wide range of dimensions and in grades suitable for a wide range of uses—from clothes pegs to massive laminated beams spanning 50 metres. Other present uses include:

- Machined framing components for recliner-rocker chairs.
- Machined framing components for quality furniture.
- Lounge, bedroom, kitchen and dining suites.
- Framing for homes.
- Framing for cupboards, wardrobes, etc.
- Shelving and drawer components.
- Laminated beams for architectural and structural use.
- Feature wall panels (solid and veneer).
- Flooring (strip and plywood squares, waterproof particle board).
- Industrial packaging, cases, crates, boxes.

and—PRESSURE TREATED for immunity against decay and insect attack, for:

- Fencing, playground equipment.
- Garden furniture.
- Saunas.
- Decking.
- Gazebos, pergolas, patios.
