At its last meeting, the Fauna Protection Advisory Committee set up a sub-committee of scientific members whose task it will be to evolve a plan of management for the fauna reserve at East Pingelly. The committee hopes it will be able to use the plan when evolved as a model for the management of the other reserves under its control. These now total more than 100.
