***Vachellia bolei* (Fabaceae: Mimosoideae), the correct name for a species from India**

The following new combination in *Vachellia* Wight & Arn. is required in accordance with Articles 52.1 and 52.2 of the *Melbourne Code* (McNeill *et al.* 2012). This is necessary because in creating *Vachellia wightii* Ragupathy, Seigler, Ebinger & Maslin, Ragupathy *et al.* (2014) erred by basing their new name on the illegitimate name, *Acacia wightii* Baker ex Benth. (Bentham 1875: 506). Although Article 58.1 of the Code does permit the re-use of an illegitimate name, this is only possible when there is 'no obstacle [to doing so] under the rules'. In this case the 'obstacle' was the existence of the legitimate name, *A. bolei* R.P.Subhedar (Subhedar 1985) and it is this name that should have been adopted as the basionym, as is done here.
