National Rivercare Initiative has been set up through the Natural Heritage Trust to assist community initiative in monitoring, education, raising awareness, planning and implementing on-ground activities at the local level which will achieve healthier rivers and waterways.

The **National Vegetation Initiative (Bushcare)** has been set up through the Natural Heritage Trust to halt the decline in the quality and extent of Australia's native vegetation cover.

The **Remnant Vegetation Protection Scheme** has been set up through the Natural Heritage Trust to provide assistance to farmers to protect native vegetation on private land, for the purpose of land, water and nature conservation.
