Journey through Roley Pools Heritage Trail during the Djilba season, for the final hike of the Six Seasons Trail Series.

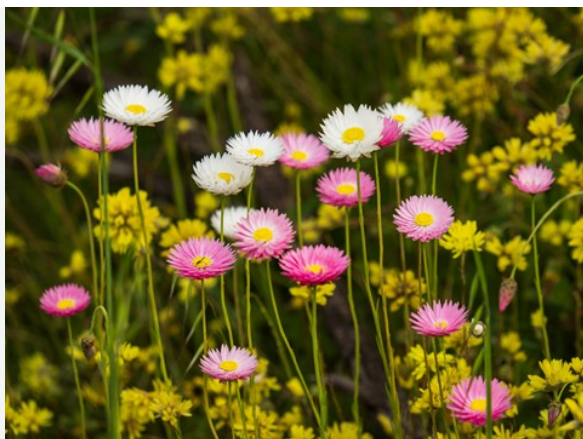

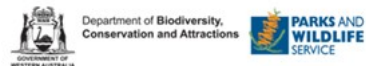
**Spring Cocky Count, The Greater
