## POPULAR NAMES FOR MARSUPIALS

It has long been felt that the study of Natural History in Western Australia has been hampered by the absence of popular names for most of our animals, and by the confusion resulting from a lack of uniformity in the use of the few already in existence.

Acting on behalf of the Trustees, the Curator of the Museum therefore convened a meeting, held at the Museum on August 16th, 1928, when the following list was prepared and recommended for general adoption. In some instances well established English names have been retained, but in the majority of cases use has been made of native names recorded by Grey, Gould or Fletcher Moore, where it has been possible to identify the animal to which the name was applied. The scientific names are those used by Le Souef and Burrell in "The Wild Animals of Australasia," London, 1926.

The list is now issued by the Trustees as Museum Leaflet No. 1.
