STOCK ACT, 1901, PART IV.—IMPORTED STOCK.

Australian and Foreign Horses Introduced and Imported.

Australian Horses.—From other Australian States.—By sea: 20 stud horses, 329 ordinary horses.

Overland: 40 stud horses, 190 stud mares, and 11,715 ordinary horses; total, 12,294.

Foreign Horses.—During the year, 43 horses were imported from Great Britain and Ireland and ther foreign countries, and were subjected to the prescribed quarantine of fourteen days in Sydney theore being allowed to go inland. Particulars as to number and breed of these horses are as follows:—
