Business Arising from the Minutes.

Thursday was a bit cold and blustery but the comet was still seen. J. Biggs thanked all the volunteers who attended for their assistance and efforts.

Treasurers Report.

o B. Harris stated that the balance of the POVG inc. account was unchanged at \$158.70 with no income or outgoings.

General Business:

o K. Ford said that he had heard about the plan for Perth Observatory to buy a 30 inch Obsession dobsonian telescope and wondered if anyone would be keen to try and build it themselves. J. Milner said it was a bad idea and from personal experience it would take far longer than expected and be of lesser quality than the one to be purchased. G. Prideaux said that he wouldn't have the time to help. J. Biggs said that the Observatory technical staff were already under a lot of pressure and would not be able to assist at this time. The idea was put aside.

- o The Summer Lecture is expected to be given by Rob McNaught at the end of March. A date has not been confirmed as it will rely on when McNaught can get a flight over. Discussion was undertaken as to whether the entry fee should be raised. Most people agreed that \$10 (double the current \$5 fee) was an acceptable price. J. Biggs said these comments would be considered when the Lecture was advertised. B. Harris complained about the quality of the screen used on the back wall outside for the Lecture and was directed to investigate the cost of hiring one that wouldn't flap in the wind.
- o G. Lowe will mark Extended tours (2.5hours) in the roster book so volunteers are aware when they are occurring when then sign up for nights. These extended tours are marked in the advertising brochure but not everyone checks them.
- o There may be an Aboriginal Astronomy Night on Saturday April 14th. This is still to be confirmed. There are 30 people on a waiting list for this night if it goes ahead.
