## CONSERVATION AND LAND MANAGEMENT ACT 1984.

## FOREST AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 1985.

MADE by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council on the recommendation of the Minister for Conservation and Land Management.

- Citation. 1. These regulations may be cited as the Forest Amendment Regulations 1985.
- Principal regulations. 2. In these regulations the Forest Regulations 1957\* are referred to as the principal regulations.
- Second Schedule amended. 3. The Second Schedule to the principal regulations is amended—
- (a) in item 1, by deleting “\$3.26” and substituting the following—  
“ \$3.47 ”; and
- (b) in item 2, by deleting paragraph (a) and substituting the following paragraph—  
“ (a) Sawn sleepers—\$2.41 per cubic metre.  
Other sawn timber—\$3.47 per cubic metre.  
Dressed flooring—\$1.68 per 100 metres.  
Logs for milling or peeling into veneer—\$1.25 per cubic metre. ”.
- Third Schedule substituted. 4. The Third Schedule to the principal regulations is deleted and the following Schedule is substituted—

### PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS by the Transfer of Land Act 1893, the Governor is empowered by Proclamation in the *Government Gazette* to revest in Her Majesty as of Her former estate all or any lands, whereof Her Majesty may become the registered proprietor, and whereas Her Majesty is now the registered proprietor of the lands described in the Schedules hereto: Now therefore, I, the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation revest in Her Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors, the land described in the Schedules hereto as of Her former estate.
