Notice of Intention to Construct a Roof over the Existing Whitfords Reservoir

TO protect the quality of the water stored in the Whitfords Reservoir, the Water Authority proposes to construct a low profile roof over the reservoir.

The maximum height of the roof will be approximately 4.5 metres above the existing earth embankments. The wall sheeting will be a bronze olive green colour and the roof sheeting will have a zinc/aluminium coated finish.
