1. This Order may be cited as the Retail Trading Hours Exemption Order (No. 8) 1990.

Extended trading hours for staff shopping



Section 12 of the Retail Trading Hours Act 1987 does not apply to the general retail shops specified in column 1 of the schedule on the day and during the hours specified opposite and corresponding to those general retail shops in column 2 of the schedule subject to only the staff of Aherns Stores and their immediate families being admitted to the general retail shops in column 1 on the day and during the hours specified in column 2.
