REASON FOR ACTION:

The Shire of Harvey sought to rationalise the tenure of Dix and Medway roads within State Forest No. 14 and 15. As a result 1.81 hectares of State Forest No. 14 and 4.94 hectares of State Forest No. 15 were excised. The Shire will close portions of unconstructed road reserve for addition to State forest, 3.85 hectares is proposed to be added to State Forest No. 14 and 4.79 hectares added to State Forest No. 15.

An order was published in the Government Gazette on 28 February 2020 to finalise the excision.


