REASON FOR ACTION:

Main Roads Western Australia requested the excision of land from State Forest No. 26 to facilitate upgrades to a 15 kilometre portion of Collie-Preston Road. On 27 March 2020 Lots 400-411 on Deposited Plan 416086 (25.9951 hectares) were excised from State Forest No. 26.

Lot 412 on Deposited Plan 416086 was also proposed for excision but due to not being labelled as State forest on the deposited plan it was overlooked. On 28 July 2020 an order was published in the Government Gazette to facilitate the excision of Lot 412 from State Forest No. 26.
