


## PROPOSED WIDENING OF PT GREAT EASTERN HIGHWAY

Main Roads WA is planning to upgrade approximately 12 kilometres of Great Eastern Highway between Sawyers Valley and the Lakes Turn-off. This upgrade involves widening of the Highway, as well as reconstruction on the current alignment, in order to provide for a dual carriageway in both directions.

The bulk of the land required by Main Roads for the upgrade is currently State forest No. 7. Late last year the approval of both Houses of Parliament was sought to revoke the dedication of the portion of State forest No. 7 involved. The Leaislative Assembly approved of the proposed revocation but the Legislative Council did not consider the matter before Parliament finished sitting for the year. It will be re-activated when Parliament resumes next month. Further advice on that aspect will be forwarded in due course.

A small portion of the planned upgrade will affect Reserve No. 18130, which has a purpose of 'Conservation and Recreation' and is vested in the Conservation Commission of WA. Both the Conservation Commission and the Minister for the Environment have endorsed the proposed p 64, 65, 135. excisions from Reserve No. 18130. Copies of pertinent correspondence in that regard are attached. Also attached is a copy of the latest Main Roads drawing, which shows the portions of Reserve No. 18130 required. The total area now being requested from that reserve is 2.2682ha. This is slightly higher than the 1.72ha originally requested. The increase is due to the previously unforeseen need to relocate Cairn Street through Reserve No. 18130.

Would you please instigate action to effect the necessary excisions from Reserve No. 18130.

EXECUTIVE COUNCIL SUBMISSION - PROPOSAL FOR THE PARTIAL REVOCATION OF STATE FOREST NOS. 7, 14, 16, 28, 32, 33 AND 58

Pursuant to section 9(2) of the Conservation and Land Management Act 1984, the Governor may cause to be laid before each House of Parliament a proposal to excise land from State forest.

Enclosed is a proposal (in duplicate) to partially revoke the dedication of State forest Nos. 7, 14, 16, 28, 32, 33 and 58 in connection with nine road matters.

For several decades, from the formation of the Forests Department in 1918 through to its amalgamation into the Department of Conservation and Land Management in 1985 and beyond, the procedure for taking land out of State forest solely for road purposes did not involve Parliamentary approval. However, the situation changed with the proclamation of the Land Administration Act. Shortly after the proclamation of that Act in 1998, the former Department of Land Administration advised that the longstanding practice of resuming roads from State forest as an administrative process using the provisions of the Public Works Act or the Local Government Act could no longer occur and that Parliamentary approval would henceforth be required to excise a proposed road from State forest.

Attached is a summary of nine road proposals, which require excision of the areas concerned from State forest Nos. 7, 14, 16, 28, 32, 33 and 58. Also attached is a set of numbered locality plans showing each of the proposed roads, realignments and widenings, associated road closures (if appropriate) and the tenure of the surrounding land.

The total area proposed for excision from State forest Nos. 7, 14, 16, 28, 32, 33 and 58 is 81.4179 hectares. Contingent upon these excisions, several unconstructed roads will be closed and added to the forest estate. The total area in that regard is about 24 hectares. Main Roads WA has offered compensation for the loss of land associated with Area No. 1. This compensation will be used to acquire replacement land.

Apart from Area Nos. 1 and 8, all of the 'proposed' roads in the attached summary have already been constructed. There are many examples of roads having been built in State forest outside the formal survey provided for them. The reasons for this vary but often the formal survey may not be the most practical alignment when it comes to actually building a road.

The nine excision proposals outlined in the attached summary have been endorsed by the Conservation Commission of WA and are now submitted for your consideration.

I shall be grateful if you would sign the enclosed Executive Council minute paper and then forward it, the accompanying explanatory note, the revocation motion (in duplicate) and the six locality plans for each area to the Department of Premier and Cabinet by 4pm 5 November 2003. This will allow the matter to be considered at the Executive Council meeting scheduled for Tuesday 12 November.

If the Governor signs the revocation proposal, draft speech notes and further plans will be provided to enable the proposal to be referred for Parliamentary consideration.

The primary purpose of this note is to progress the proposed excisions from State forest Nos 7, 14, 16, 28, 32, 33 and 58. However, the opportunity is also taken to seek your approval for the proposed excision of:

(a) 1.72 hectares from Reserve No. 18130 (Conservation) in connection with the planned widening of Great Eastern Highway (Area No. 1); and

(b) 3696 square metres of the Lane Poole Reserve (A↑39822) in relation to formally widening the Harvey-Quindanning Road (Area No. 5).
