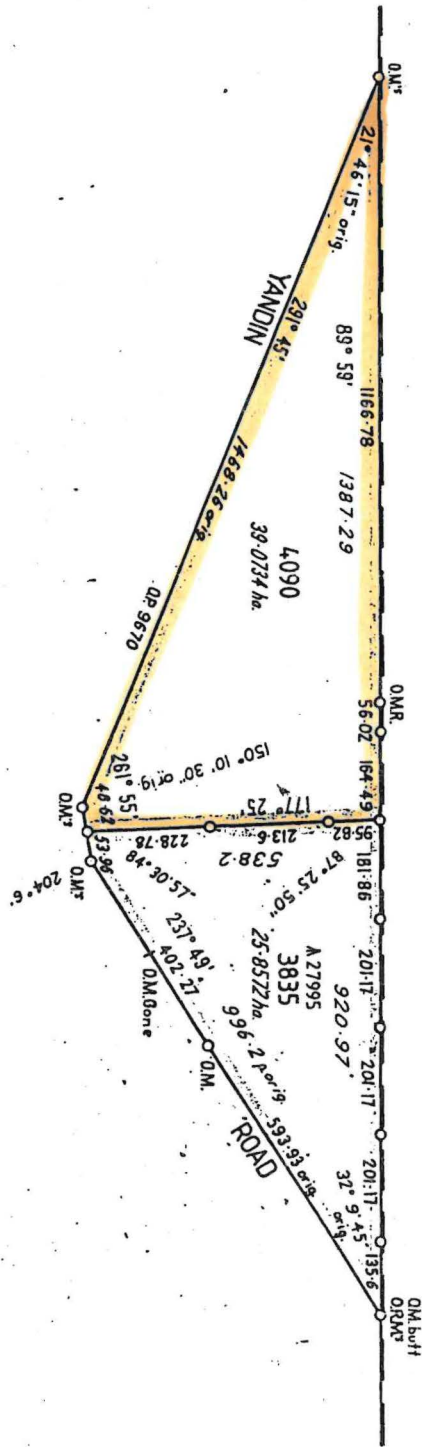

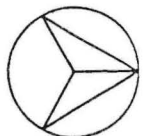

FISHERIES ACT 1905

Part IIIB—Processing Licences

FD 524/86.

THE public is hereby notified that I have issued a permit to K B & J M Watters and Fascine Developments Pty Ltd of PO Box 499, Carnarvon, to establish a processing establishment to process fish in pursuance of the provisions of section 35C of the Fisheries Act 1905 on board licensed fishing boat *Lynette* registered number LFBG164, subject to the following conditions:

That the processing establishment—

1. Shall comply with the requirements of the Fisheries Act 1905, and all Regulations, Orders in Council and Notices and Ministerial Directions issued thereunder.
2. Shall not be used for the processing of rock lobster or prawns.
3. Shall comply with the requirements of the Health Act 1911.
4. Shall be registered as an export establishment pursuant to the provisions of the Parliament of the Commonwealth Export Control Act 1982, and Orders made thereunder, more specifically the Prescribed Goods (General) Orders and the Fish Orders, should it be used to process fish for export.
5. Shall not be used for the processing of marron (*Cherax tenuimanus*) unless a licence is held under section 39C of the Fisheries Act 1905.
6. Shall not be used for the processing of fish or crustacea caught by any other vessel.

In accordance with the provisions of section 35K, any person aggrieved by this decision, may within 14 days after publication of this notice, appeal against the decision or order by serving on the Minister for Fisheries a statement in writing on the grounds of their appeal.

FISHERIES ACT 1905

Part IIIB—Processing Licences

FD 799/85.

THE public is hereby notified that I have issued a permit to Messrs L. H. Pinniger and F. Ebbet of RMB 1118 South Coast Highway, Denmark, to establish a processing establishment to process fish in pursuance of the provisions of section 35C of the Fisheries Act 1905 at Location 1653 South Coast Highway, Denmark, subject to the following conditions:

That the processing establishment—

1. Shall comply with the requirements of the Fisheries Act 1905 and all Regulations, Orders in Council, and Notices and Ministerial Directions issued thereunder.
2. Shall not be used for the processing of rock lobster, prawns, mulies, tuna or Australian salmon except as provided by Clauses 8 and 9.
3. Shall comply with the requirements of the Health Act 1911.
4. Shall comply with the requirements of any town planning scheme or interim development order gazetted under the provisions of the Town Planning and Development Act 1928 (amended) or the Metropolitan Region Town Planning Scheme Act 1959 (amended).
5. Shall be registered as an export establishment pursuant to the provisions of the Parliament of the Commonwealth Export Control Act 1982, and Orders made thereunder, more specifically the Prescribed Goods (General) Orders and the Fish Orders, should it be used to process fish for export.
6. Shall not be used for the processing of marron (*Cherax tenuimanus*) unless a licence is held under section 39C of the Fisheries Act 1905.

7. The licensee shall lodge with the Department of Fisheries no later than the 15th day of each month, a return of wetfish processed for the preceding month, specifying the name of the fisherman, the boat number or professional fisherman's licence number, anchorage from which the vessel operates, the species and live weight processed. Where no wetfish have been processed a "nil" return shall be submitted.
8. Shall not be used to process Australian salmon other than as a food fish for human consumption in accordance with a Notice under section 38 of the Fisheries Act 1905 published in the *Government Gazette* on 20 February 1978.
9. Shall not be used to process Australian salmon by canning.
10. The licensee shall supply such documents and records as determined by a Fisheries Enforcement Officer to provide an adequate record of all Australian salmon processed and the final destination of each sale and quantity.
