



# EXCISIONS FROM THOMSONS LAKE NATURE RESERVE (RESERVE A15556) AND HARRY WARING MARSUPIAL RESERVE (RESERVE A29241) DUE TO THE REALIGNMENT AND WIDENING OF RUSSELL ROAD

Thomsons Lake Nature Reserve (Reserve A15556) and Harry Waring Marsupial Reserve (Reserve A29241) are both class A nature reserves vested in the Conservation Commission of Western Australia.

In October 2005, the City of Cockburn contacted the Department of Conservation and Land Management (CALM) requesting approval to realign and widen Russell Road, which runs between the two reserves (Map 1).

The eastern part of Russell Road, between Thomsons Lake Nature Reserve and Harry Waring Marsupial Reserve, is located north of the dedicated road reserve. It is proposed to realign this portion of Russell Road so that it is now located entirely within the road reserve (Map 2). Additionally, this portion of Russell Road will be widened (as indicated in the Metropolitan Region Scheme – Map 3) and will require the excision of land from both Thomsons Lake Nature Reserve and Harry Waring Marsupial Reserve (Map 4).

The proposed realignment and widening are the result of the need to provide a safe traffic intersection on the eastern boundary of Thomsons Lake Nature Reserve and Harry Waring Marsupial Reserve.

In February 2006, the proposal was endorsed by the Conservation Commission of Western Australia on the condition that the City of Cockburn should do the following.

- 1. Remove the existing road base through Thomsons Lake Nature Reserve and rehabilitate the area (about 0.4 ha) with local native species to the satisfaction of CALM.
- 2. Remove any bitumen road base, pipes and other debris associated with previous roads from the northern portion of Harry Waring Marsupial Reserve.
- 3. Re-align the vermin-proof fence at Harry Waring Marsupial Reserve to the satisfaction of CALM.
- 4. Provide an agricultural fence along the revised cadastral boundary at the south-east corner of Thomsons Lake Nature Reserve.

I therefore seek your approval to excise approximately 1846 m<sup>2</sup> from Thomsons Lake Nature Reserve (Reserve A15556) and approximately 203 m<sup>2</sup> from Harry Waring Marsupial Reserve (Reserve A29241) for the alignment and widening of Russell Road.

Section 45(4) of the Land Administration Act 1997 (LAA) requires excisions for roads to be tabled in Parliament and to be subject to disallowance. There is no requirement under the LAA for you to approve such excisions but I would prefer to obtain your approval.

The road excision papers will be tabled in Parliament by the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, who is responsible for administering the LAA.

## 6.6 Realignment and widening of Russell Road, affecting Thomsons Lake Nature Reserve and Harry Waring Marsupial Reserve

Brendan Dooley, CALM, advised the meeting that Russell Road is not currently entirely within the road reserve and the proposal would correct this. It is proposed to move the road rather than the road reserve due to safety concerns for trucks and a new intersection that is being developed.

The widening of the road requires additional land be excised from the reserves. The widening proposal is within the Metropolitan Region Scheme.

Flora surveys have found no significant species within either the Thomsons Lake Nature Reserve or Harry Waring Marsupial Reserve.

The City of Cockburn will conduct rehabilitation work, including removing the road base and pipes and fixing the fencing. It was noted that rehabilitation is part of the project and is separate from any offset.

Resolution 9/06

The Conservation Commission resolved to seek the approval of the Minister for the Environment for the tabling in Parliament of the excision from Thomsons Lake Nature Reserve (Reserve A15556) of about 1846m² and from Harry Waring Marsupial Reserve (Reserve A29241) of about 203 m² for the widening of Russell Road.

#### 6.7 Leases and Licences batch for discussion

As many of the apiary permits concern the Walpole Wilderness Area and the Management Planning Review Committee is currently reviewing the Walpole Wilderness Area Draft Management Plan consideration of the apiary permits was deferred until the next meeting. This will allow time for ensuring permits are not issued that are inconsistent with proposals within the draft management plan.

Rod Quartermain, CALM, advised the meeting that the 2 licence proposals concerning the Mitchell River National Park represent the start of the licensing process for tour operators in that area. Licensing is a new requirement resulting from the recent compatible operations declaration. The proposals are not yet covered by the Tour Operators Handbook but the activities will be covered in the next Tour Operators Handbook. Consultation with the local Indigenous community has occurred and they are agreeable to the proposed licences being issued.

It was noted that the Mitchell River National Park needs a management plan and therefore the rolling plan for management planning needs to be reviewed to include the park.

Regarding the licence renewal for horse trail rides in the Lane Poole Reserve, it was noted that the reserve's management plan is currently being reviewed. The review is not yet at a point to indicate how horse riding is likely to be dealt with but there are not expected to be a lot of changes to current activities. Rod Quartermain is to advise the proponent of the management planning process to ensure she is able to participate.

There were no issues raised concerning the licence for activities in the Nilgen and Wanagarren Nature Reserves.

**Resolution 10/06** The Conservation Commission resolved to endorse the 4 licences for forwarding to the Minister for approval.
