REASON FOR ACTION

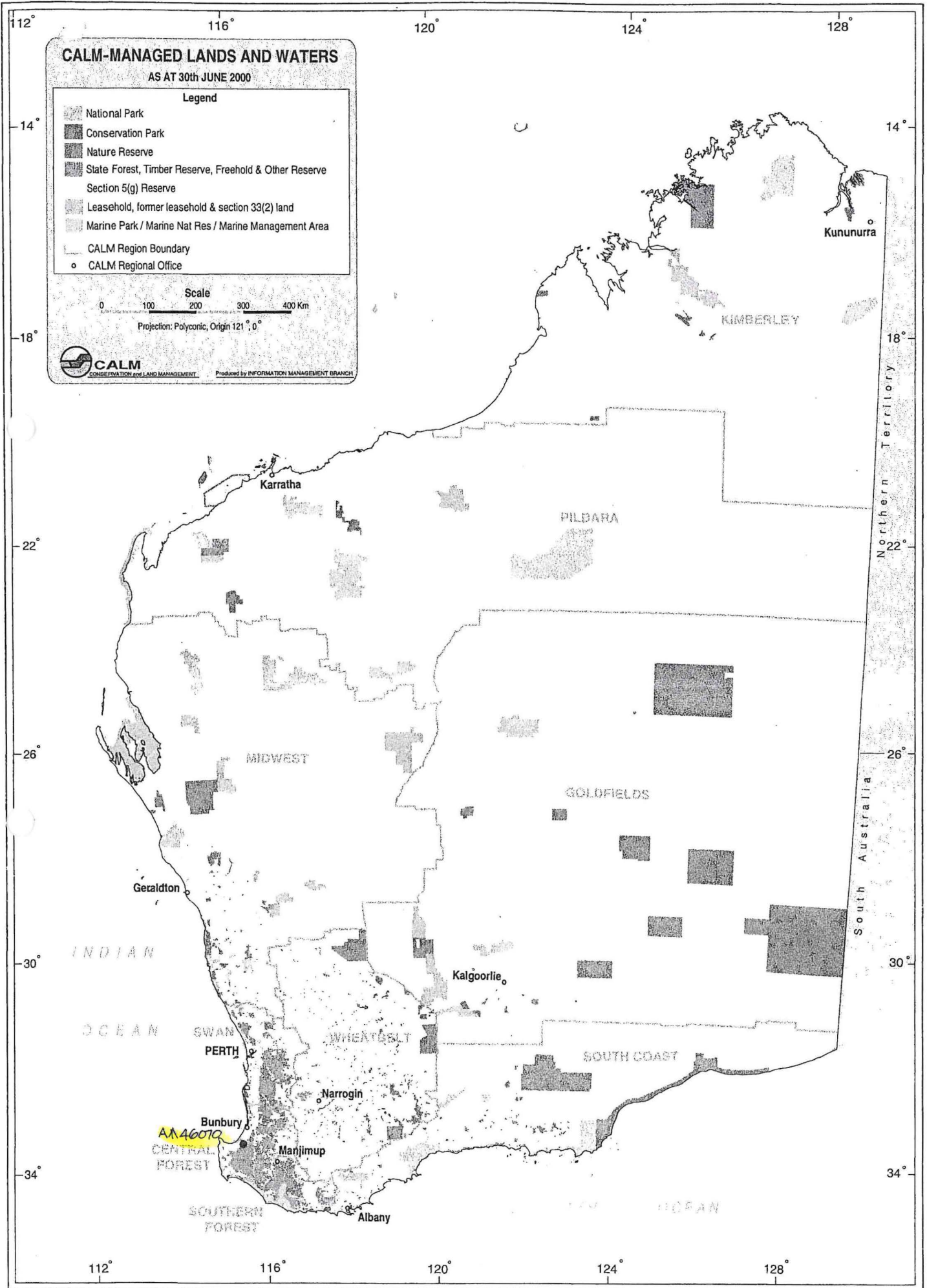
Creation of a new class A nature reserve, with a management order issued to the Conservation Commission for the purpose 'Conservation of Flora and Fauna'.

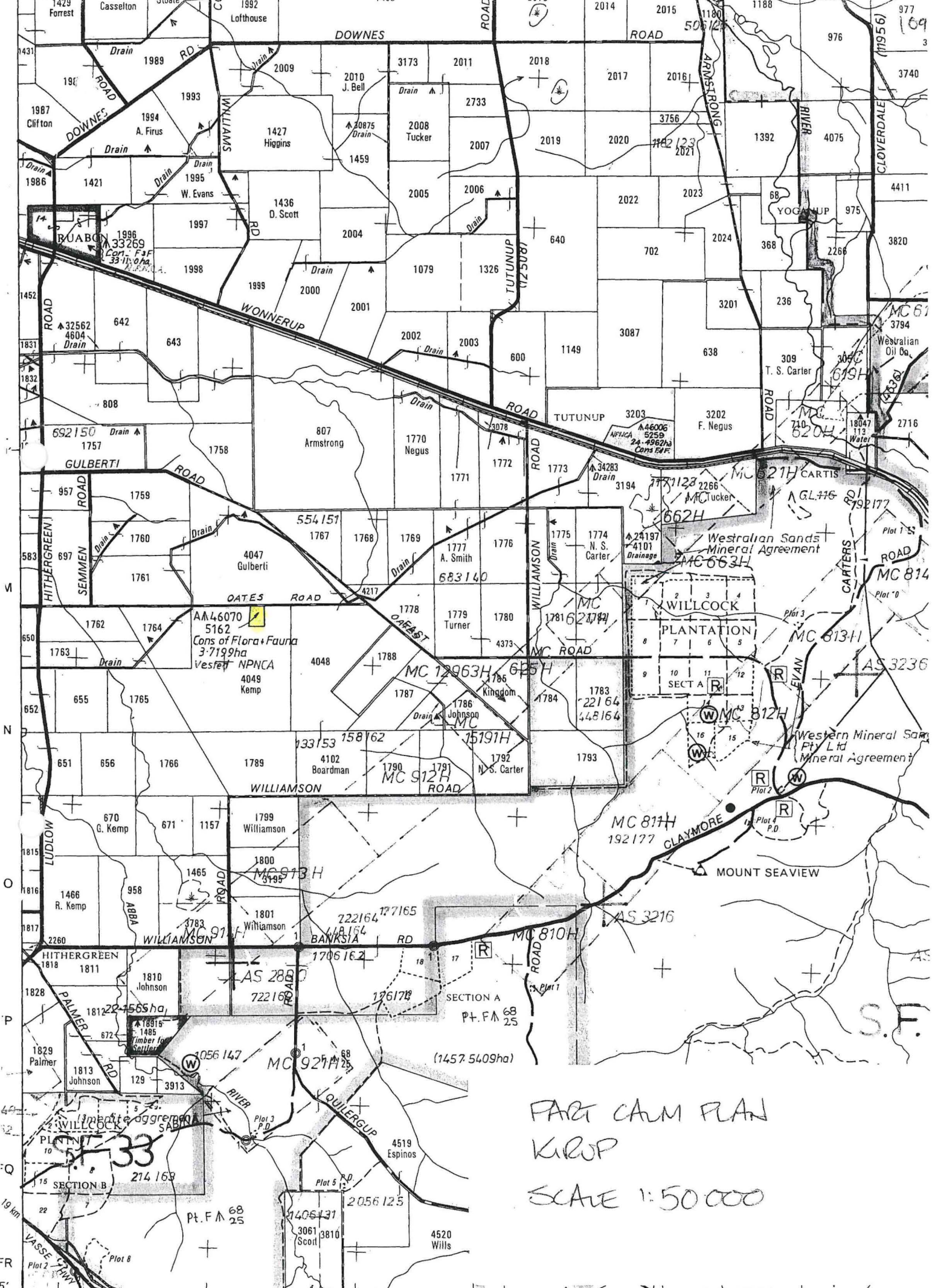
Area: 3.72 hectares

The reserve has very high value for conservation. It contains the only population of McCutcheon's Grevillea (*Grevillea maccutcheonii*). This species was declared as Rare Flora under the *Wildlife Conservation Act 1950* in 1994 and was ranked as critically endangered in September 1995. It is recognised as one of the most threatened plant species in Australia and is endemic to Busselton.
