REASON FOR ACTION

Creation of a new class A nature reserve with the purpose "Conservation of Flora and Fauna" with a Management Order issued to the Conservation Commission.

Area: 72.8 hectares

This area of bushland was previously freehold and has been purchased by the Department. It lies on the south-western edge of Lake Muir Nature Reserve. Its vegetation comprises marri (*Corymbia calophylla*) and jarrah (*Eucalyptus marginata*) on the bank of the lake, with paperbark and samphire on the lake flats. The Lake Muir/Uncup Region is one of 13 inland complexes of natural wetlands in Western Australia. It is the only wetland complex in near pristine condition and it supports important habitat for waterbirds.
