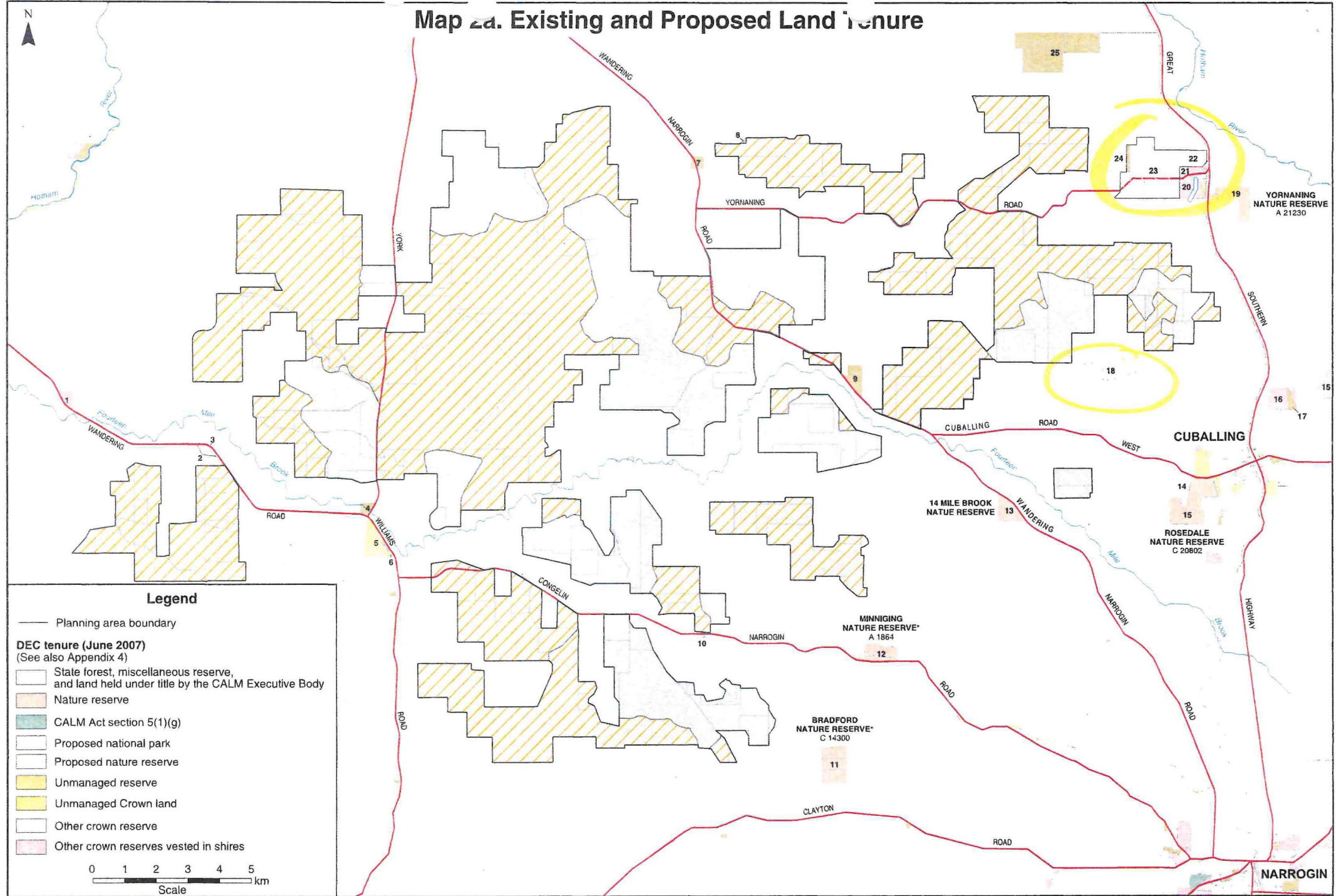

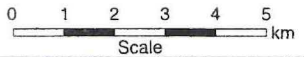

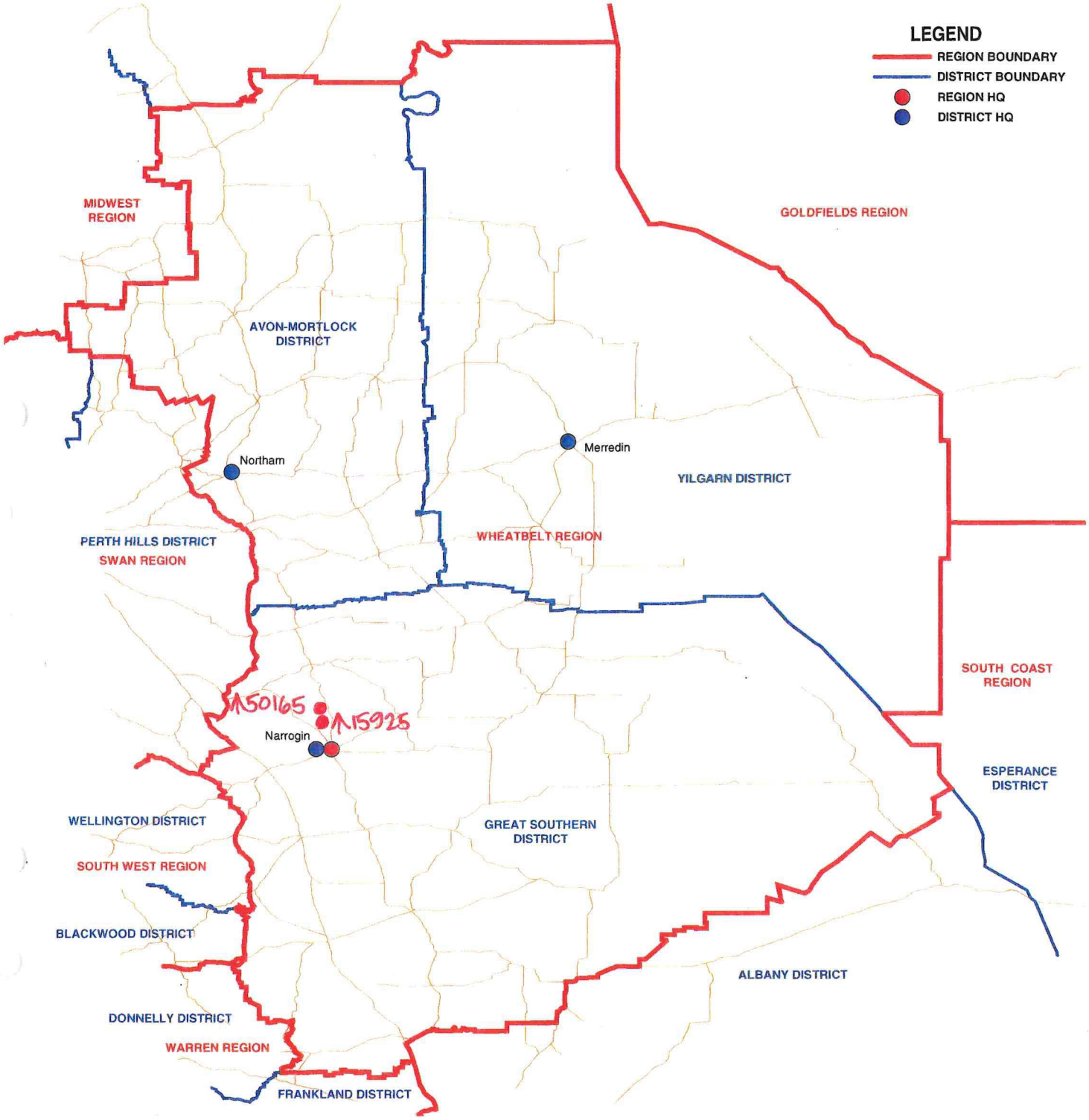
Map 2a. Existing and Proposed Land Tenure



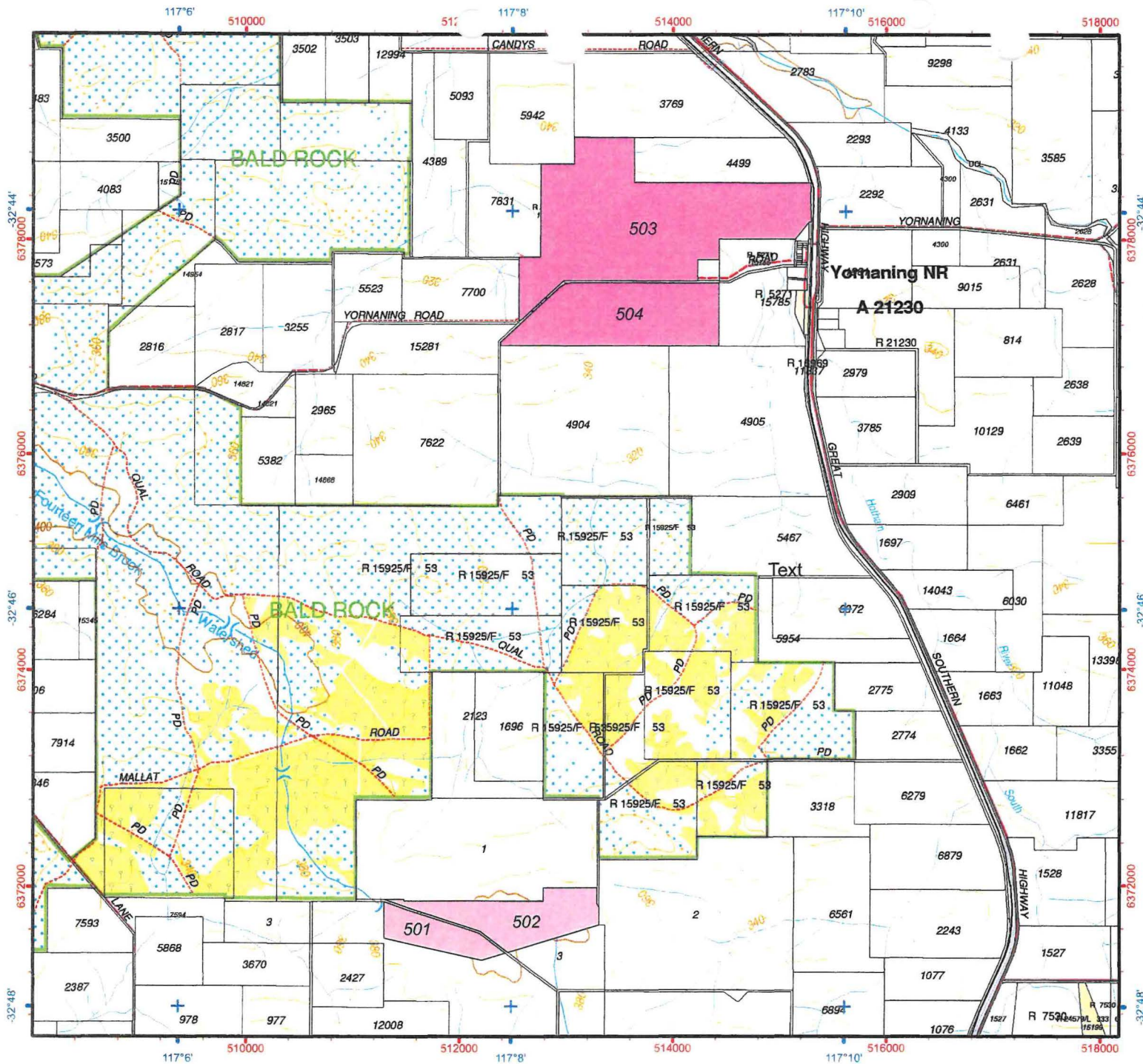

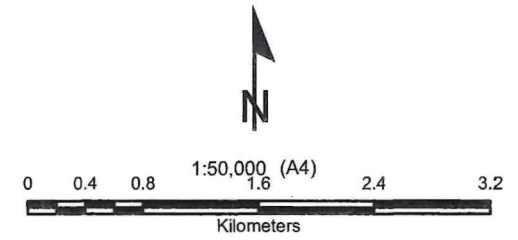

"WATER SUPPLY" RESERVES NEAR YORNANING

The Water Authority of Western Australia has advised that it wishes to relinquish control over "Water Supply" Reserves 4698, 15869, 6593 and portion of 15925. These areas are shown bordered red on the enclosed print.

The Shire of Cuballing has expressed an interest in obtaining Reserve 4698, which contains the Yornaning dam site, to develop as a tourist attraction and presumably, the northernmost portion of Reserve 15925, as it contains suitable road making materials. As you are aware the southern portion of Reserve 15925 is contained within State Forest Number 53. Your comments on these matter would be most appreciated.
