PROPOSED RESERVATION OF FREEHOLD PURCHASES, WHEATBELT REGION

The Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions (DBCA) is seeking to progress the reservation of purchased freehold lands in the Wheatbelt Region.

Lot 111 on Plan 60132

The 324.708 ha Lot is located within the Shire of Dumbleyung and sits adjacent to Tarin Rock Nature Reserve (Class 'A', Reserve No. 25711) to the southeast (map at attachment 2). The Lot is of significant conservation value, containing vegetation that is underrepresented in the State's conservation reserve system. DBCA proposes the addition of this Lot to the Tarin Rock Nature Reserve (Class 'A', Reserve No. 25711).

DBCA notes that the Lot currently exists as Unallocated Crown Land due to an administrative error. However, the Lot was purchased by the Department in freehold in 2008 for addition to the conservation estate, and as such, the proposal above is consistent with the original reason for purchase.

Lot 500 on Plan 55419

The 658.47 ha Lot is located approximately 14 km southwest of Beacon within the Shire of Mount Marshall (map at attachment 1). The Lot is bounded on all sides by freehold property. DBCA purchased the Lot in 2007 for addition to the conservation estate, in recognition of the high presence of Beard's vegetation association 1024 (Shrubland; Mallee & Casuarina thicket) and 142 (Medium woodland York Gum & Salmon Gum). Both vegetation associations are under-represented in the reserve system in the Avon Wheatbelt IBRA subregion. DBCA notes that there are also historical records of Malleefowl mounds within the vicinity of the proposed Lot for reservation.

DBCA proposes the reservation of this Lot as an unclassified nature reserve.

The Department of Mines, Industry Regulation and Safety (DMIRS) previously provided comment on these proposals in 2008 and 2009, respectively. At the time, DMIRS did not object to the proposed reservation of the two areas but required a 30m depth limit be applied to each reserve. DBCA regarded the placement of a depth limit on the proposed reserves to be inappropriate with conserving the significant environmental values at both sites.

As part of the process required for creation of and amendments to Crown reserves, DBCA is seeking the necessary approvals. Accordingly, the Department kindly requests that DMIRS considers the proposals above and provides support by means of section 16(3) clearance under the *Mining Act 1987*.
