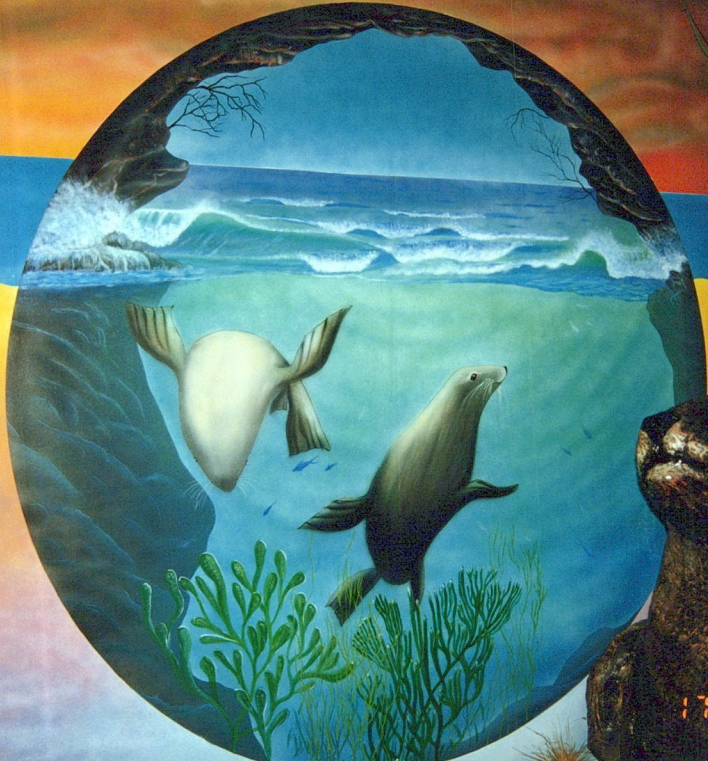

years ago.

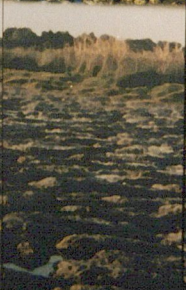
