After the giant jarrah trees were felled—the rebirth of forest wealth.

Jarrah seedling showing lignotuber and strong tap root. The best remaining jarrah forest occurs on the lateritic gravels of the Darling Range.

Ecologically, the jarrah forest is a "climax" community—the plant species represented have reached a stable equilibrium with site conditions, which are particularly harsh in the jarrah forest region.
