

LeTOURNEAU-WESTINGHOUSE 'C' TOURNATRACTOR FITTED WITH LOGGING  
WINCH AND TOWING A MODEL LA90 LOGGING ARCH, WORKING IN JARRAH FOREST  
WESTERN AUSTRALIA

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The 'C' Tournatractor is hauling the big log away, negotiating an adverse grade of 6% in 2nd gear; the ground condition, as can be seen in the photo, was damp, sandy loam and laterite gravel.

The electric motors which drive the Model 'C' Winch can be seen on the top right hand side of unit behind the protection guard. The weight of the load is held by means of multi-disc brakes on the electric motors.

The 'C' Tournatractor has constant mesh transmission and torque converter drive. This allows the operator to make changes from one gear ratio to another on the run, thereby keeping the log on the move between these instantaneous gear changes. One of the chief advantages of this transmission is speed, which can be maintained and gained where conditions permit.
