A "Treever" was a Massey-Ferguson 35 tractor [originally known as a "retriever"] fitted with a specially designed 4WD, working as a "short-wood-forwarder", self-loading then carrying and unloading small pine logs. The first Treever had been brought to WA after a report by Bill Kerruish, of the Forestry and Timber Bureau, recommended it for operations on the sand-plains north of Perth. Locally, modifications and specially built grapples, developed mainly by Jack Reynolds, turned the Treevers into very able units when handled by experienced drivers.
