4 (1)	C. Walsh & Family	Wants Star Swamp preserved.
46 (2)	L.G. Jennings	To preserve the swamp's integrity the proposed reserve should be expanded to include adjacent 90 ha.
151 (3)	V. Patterson	Outlines importance of wetlands such as Star Swamp to migratory birds. Star Swamp cannot survive without upland area being preserved and whole composite area should be reserved with suitable management programme being implemented.
173-197(4)	Our Lady of Grace Convent School Class 5C	Series of submissions describing value of Star Swamp as a haven for flora and fauna and a place for children to explore and picnic and calling for preservation of the Swamp.
198 (40)	G.G. Phillips	To ensure integrity of the wetland a buffer zone of 90 ha should be reserved.
227 (5)	G. Foster	The whole wetland and bushland area of Star Swamp should be reserved - it has potential to become comparable in value to King's Park.
253 (5)	P. & J. Calleja.	Proposes that Star Swamp bushland be made an "A" Class reserve because of its conservation, recreation and education value.
254 (5)	E. Blaxell	Calls for preservation of Star Swamp bushland because of its array of bird life and flora and fauna and its location which enables large numbers of people to enjoy it.
256 (6)	City of Stirling	Reserves area should be extended eastwards to Marmion Avenue. Opposes M35.1. Whole area should be vested in City of Stirling for "Public Recreation". The development /management plan for area would include input from govt. depts. and be subject to final ratification of City of Stirling and Dept. of Cons. & Environment. Opposes joint vesting, unless it facilitates joint funding.
319 (8)	S. Bullin	Expresses concern at degradation of Star Swamp by runoff polluted with fertilizer and rubbish and by growth of lupins.
354 (8)	K. Higgins	Calls for preservation of Star Swamp because of animal life there.

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355 (8)	Anonymous	Supports proposed Star Swamp reserve.
409 (10)	K. Avenell	Calls for reservation of entire Star Swamp bushland for preservation of area's wildlife.
453 (10)	H.J. Winston	Proposes that entire Star Swamp bushland, bounded by Marmion Avenue, North Beach Road, Hope Street and Beach Road be reserved. The area is of value for its wildflowers and bird life and its tranquil seclusion.
458 (11)	D.E. Avenell	Star Swamp bushland should be preserved as part of Perth's open space system: it has both recreational and educational value.
463 (11)	R.D. Kolb	Endorses M35.1. Calls for reservation of largest possible area of buffer zone - at least that area outlined in Fig. 108.
470 (11)	G. Foster	Proposes reservation of whole area bounded by Marmion Avenue, North Beach Road, Hope Street and Black Road.
472 (11)	M.W. Moran	Wants Star Swamp bushland preserved particularly for its value as a play area for children.
476 (11)	B.A. & J. Gobby	Calls for preservation of whole area bounded by Marmion Avenue, North Beach Road, Hope Street and Beach Road. The area's flora is particularly valued.
496 (12)	I. Cherry	Calls for reservation of whole area bounded by Marmion Avenue, North Beach Road, Hope Street and Beach Road.
527 (12)	S. Barker	Calls for reservation of whole area bounded by Beach Road, Marmion Avenue, North Beach Road and Hope Street, both because of conservation and recreation value of bushland and because this would provide buffer zone protecting swamp itself.
546 (12)	D. Teaser	Wants Star Swamp reserved.
570 (13)	M. Tate	Opposes proposed boundary of reserve as too small to safely encompass the wetlands and safeguard the feeding and breeding grounds of the bird life. Reserve should be expanded to include whole area bounded by Beach Road, Hope Street, North Beach Road and Marmion Avenue.
576 (13)	Department of Fisheries and Wildlife	Endorses M35.1 though inclusion of water as a purpose is opposed. Endorses M35.2.

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590 (13)	R. Pullen	Speaks of recreational value of area and supports preservation of both swamp and bushland.
626 (14)	J. Faulkner	Calls for reservation of swamp and adjacent bushland within area bounded by Marmion Avenue, North Beach Road, Hope Street and Beach Road.
638 (14)	M. and B. Best	Wants swamp and bushland maintained in their present state as a community reserve, within area bounded by Marmion Avenue, Beach Road, Hope Street and North Beach Road.
645 (14)	L. Hemsley	Calls for conservation of Star Swamp wetlands because area contains both special and diverse natural features and is an ideal recreational haven amid urban sprawl.
653 (14)	J. Arthur, E. Bramwell, D. Walsh and P. Beard.	Endorses.
664 (15)	A. and K. Wylie	Star Swamp reserve should be expanded to take in whole area bounded by North Beach Road, Hope Street, Beach Road, and Marmion Avenue for these reasons : (i) bushland to east of swamp is of importance in itself as a recreational and educational area and as example of ecosystem once predominant on the coastal plain. (ii) additional area required as buffer zone against overuse, pollution and fire.
678 (15)	G. McGilligan	Agrues that Star Swamp reserve should include whole area bounded by North Beach Road, Hope Street, Beach Road, and Marmion Avenue for these reasons : (i) whole area is used by schools (ii) restriction of reserve to present size would lead to pollution of swamp and alteration of water table. (iii) land east of swamp is excellent example of flora and fauna once characteristic of coastal plain.
704 (15)	G.N. Anderson	Whole area bounded by North Beach Road, Marmion Avenue, Boundary Road and Hope Street should be reserved. Land owned by State Housing Commission or other public or private bodies should be reclaimed by an off-setting of Crown land of equivalent value elsewhere.
725 (16)	P.G. Wasley	Supports making a community reserve of area bounded by Hope Street, Beach Road, Marmion Avenue and North Beach Road. The area is of particular recreational or educational value.

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759 (17)	Department of Fisheries and Wildlife	Endorses M35.1 though considers there is insufficient justification for making water part of purpose of reserve.
762 (17)	D. Smith	Argues for reservation of whole area between Marmion Avenue and Hope Street to protect the wildlife and retain recreational opportunities provided by the area.
763 (17)	T. Ayres	Wants reservation of whole area between Hope Street and Marmion Avenue because of its recreational value and its wildlife.
765 (17)	L. Hayden	Wants reservation of Star Swamp and adjacent bushland because of use of area by large numbers of people including school groups.
766 (17)	L. Radnedge	Wants whole area between Hope Street and Marmion Avenue reserved because of its recreational value.
770 (17)	D. Bromley	Wants reservation of whole area between Hope Street and Marmion Avenue because of its wildlife and its recreational value.
773 (17)	N. Thomson	Wants reservation of Star Swamp and adjacent bushland because of area's recreational value.
774 (17)	M. McCallum	Wants reservation of Star Swamp and adjacent bushland because such large open space available for recreation enhances the suburban environment.

792 (17)	A. Hancock	Wants reservation of whole area between Marmion Avenue and Hope Street. The bushland east of Star Swamp is required as buffer zone to prevent pollution of swamp itself as well as being of recreational and educational value.
794 (17)	P. Clark	Argues for reservation of whole area bounded by North Beach Road, Hope Street, Beach Road and Marmion Avenue because of its recreational and conservation value and because the bushland is needed as a buffer zone to protect the swamp from pollution.
815 (18)	G. Gillham	Calls for reservation of bushland adjacent to the swamp as being of value in itself and also necessary to maintain the correct water level of the swamp.
825 (18)	J. R. Clark	Calls for reservation of whole area bounded by Marmion Avenue, Beach Road, Hope Street and North Beach Road. The whole area is of recreational and educational value and contains bird, tree and floral life worthy of conservation. Development of housing in bushland area would lead to pollution of the swamp,
940 (19)	L. Nigot	Calls for reservation of whole area bounded by North Beach Road, Hope Street, Beach Road, and Marmion Avenue because area forms a unique natural enclave amid urban sprawl and because preservation of the bushland is necessary to protect the swamp.
973 (20)	S. Harris	Calls for reservation of land to east of swamp to act as a buffer zone.
990 (20)	W.A. National Parks & Reserves Association.	Opposes housing development in area of swamp's watershed.
998 (21)	A.C. Watson	Calls for reservation of whole area between Hope Street and Marmion Avenue because of its value as a natural recreational area and because the bushland is required to protect the swamp from pollution and flooding.

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1036 (22)	Western Australian Naturalists Club, Darling Range Branch.	Endorses M35.1 and M35.2
1044 (22)	Students of the Environmental Science Class 1G1, Churchlands College of Advanced Education.	Argues for extension of proposed boundaries of reserve to include bushland to the east, preferably as far as Marmion Avenue, for these reasons : (i) the bushland area is an integral part of Star Swamp ecosystem supporting a diversity of bird and plant life, and is of great recreational value. (ii) the bushland is needed as a buffer zone between the swamp and urban development - clearing of bushland for housing would cause a rise in water level of swamp with serious consequences for surrounding vegetation.
1052 (22)	T.A. & G. Henry	Endorses.
1054 (22)	E.M. Cook	Calls for preservation of Star Swamp along with adequate buffer zone.
1075 (23)	West Australian Wildflower Society.	Opposes proposed boundaries of reserve as being too small - should be extended eastward to top of hill.
1117 (24)	D.M. Edwards	Opposes proposed boundaries of reserve as being too small to prevent degradation of the swamp or ensure protection of the area's many species of flora and fauna. The reserve should be extended to include whole area bounded by Hope Street, Beach Road, Marmion Avenue and North Beach Road.
1158 (25)	L. Stretch	Supports.
1252 (26)	P. Bridgewater	Suggests that prime wetland ecosystems within M35 be recognised and given appropriate protection and management.
1274 (27)	Trigg North Beach Waterman	Opposes proposed boundaries of reserve and submits that they should be extended to include whole area bounded by North Beach Road, Hope Street, Beach Road and Marmion Ave.
1275 (27)	Community Association.	The larger area is necessary for these reasons: (i) to ensure a continued diversity of plant, animal and bird life. (ii) because the wetland cannot survive without its watershed; a large buffer zone is required to reduce adverse effects of polluted run off and bushfires. (iii) to cope with increased use due to growing population of northern suburbs.

A. & A. Bloemen

Endorses submission made by Trigg North Beach Waterman Community Association proposing that 90 ha bounded by North Beach Road, Marmion Avenue, Beach Road and Hope Street be made into a reserve.

Govt. depts. holding land in area should be given land elsewhere in exchange.

Opposes any housing development on bushland adjacent to swamp, being considered of great value as natural recreational area.

J. Bloemen

Wants bushland area reserved along with swamp because of its conservation and recreation value and because housing development would lead to pollution of the swamp.

Supports submission made by Trigg North Beach Waterman Community Association.

Considers the bushland area of recreational value and calls for reservation of whole area bounded by Marmion Avenue, Beach Road, Hope Street and North Beach Road.

Wishes to see reserve extended eastwards to Marmion Avenue.

Calls for reservation of whole area of swamp and bushland. Land owned by state authorities in area should be exchanged with alternative land elsewhere in metro. area.

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1486 (32)

Dept. of Lands & Surveys

The Dept. is considering ways of acquiring swamp through exchange with land elsewhere in State.

Suggests that recomm. M35.2 be amended to read : "Subject to acquisition of S.H.C. being successful, the land (should) be added to Reserve A21406".
